## Pierson Township tax bills are mailed in July (Summer Bill) and December (Winter Bill).

From taxes collected, the Township distributes most of the collections to different taxing authorities – such as Montcalm County and school districts.


Pierson Township only keeps about 1-2% of tax dollars.
