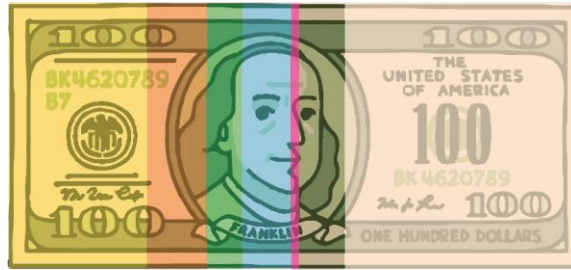


Pierson Township tax bills are mailed in July (Summer Bill) and December (Winter Bill).

From taxes collected, the Township distributes most of the collections to different taxing authorities – such as Montcalm County and school districts.

*Pierson Township only keeps about 1-2% of tax dollars.*

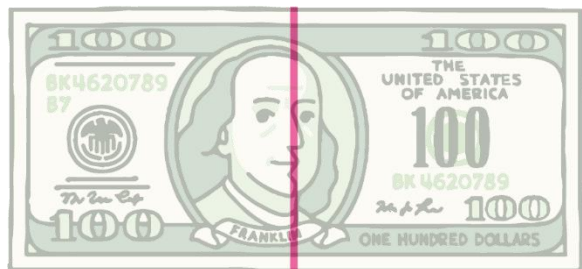


For every hundred dollars, per year:  
 Summer: 10.3066 mill = \$24.29 paid in taxes  
 Winter: 14.4755 mill = \$34.12 paid in taxes
